Anti-Terrorist Perimeter Security



Location: Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue Maida Vale London

Brief: To create an aesthetically pleasing secure perimeter to the Synagogue due to heightened level of threat.

Solution: SP400 Static Bollards.

The Spanish and Portuguese Jewish Congregation had been alerted to a heightened level of threat that the Synagogues were likely to come under. Due to the sensitive nature of the site an aesthetically pleasing solution had to be found that could prevent a 7.5t vehicle from penetrating the perimeter, along with keeping in the charities tight budget constraints.

Representatives from ATG Access visited the site in London's Maida Vale to discuss the feasibility of installing a bollard system in such a sensitive area. ATG Access met with the designers from the Congregation at a very early stage and was able to identify any potential problems and design the system to elevate these before work commenced. ATG Access was able to offer a bespoke finish to the SP400 fixed bollard that would match the aesthetics of the surrounding area.

ATG Access designed a layout which maximised available standoff from the Synagogue and minimised disruption to existing tree lines.

Standard Foundation SP400 fixed bollards were utilised then fitted with an aesthetic RAL sleeve which provided a holistic style to the project. Shallow Mount fixed bollards were used where appropriate to overcome services and damage to trees in the area.

ATG Access assisted in the design process with the architects then followed the installation through by manufacturing the bollard system once an order was received.

ATG Access undertook all aspects of the project including design, civil works including street surface upgrading, and commissioning.
