Automatic Rising Bollards

Location: Chester Bus Gate

Brief: To prevent the road being used as a rat run into the City Centre

Solution: ATG VP700 Automatic Bollards



ATG Access VP700 Automatic bollards are built to the highest quality standards and are Highways Agency approved.

A bus priority system was needed within Chester, primarily intended to stop the through road being used as a rat run to gain access into the city centre.

Two VP700 automatic rising bollards were installed to manage the traffic.

The bollard system operates around the clock 24/7 to allow only authorised vehicles through.

Buses and Hackney cabs are fitted with tags/transponders. When the vehicle enters the approach loop it is detected, this then lowers the bollards upon approach, the bollards return to the up position once the vehicle passes over.

ATG Access incorporated the same tagging system that the bus fleet already had in place in Chester.
