Location: Sussex Gardens - London

Brief: To stop people abusing the parking spaces

Solution: ATG Access 101 Removable bollards
ATG Access 101 Fixed bollards



John Todd secretary of Paddington Management Co. required a solution to the shared hotel parking spaces in Sussex Gardens. A total of 6 Hotels in this road shared the limited parking spaces in a prime area of Paddington. Abuse of the parking had reached breaking point as nobody had control over the spaces as the bollards in place were old and could be removed by anyone. Non residents were also using it to park there for free.

John Todd required a removable lockable bollard that was robust and fairly tall as 4x4's would knock into low bollards

ATG designed a special 900mm Tall 101mm Ø Removable Bollard with a special eyelet on the side to enable a chain to be padlocked onto it.

To compliment these 900mm H static bollards were to be used on the pavement to stop cars parking on the kerb. In total 20 No. Removable Bollards & 30 Statics were ordered.

Spade Oak Construction completed the installation as they were also resurfacing the road at the same time.
